

Supported Village Long Itchington

With the support of Long Itchington Parish Council, NHW, Stratford District Council, Warwickshire CC and the Police and Crime Commissioner, Warwickshire Police are pleased to announce that Long Itchington is working towards becoming the first supported village in the South of the County!

What does a supported village mean?

A household's possessions are security marked and signage is handed to those who take part to display on their property and displayed throughout the parish. The aim is to achieve 50% coverage via property marking, which makes loss from burglaries much less likely for the whole community.

Following a successful first event in March we are now holding a second event.
